During the event, Deputy Prime Minister Tharman Shanmugaratnam, Advisor to Jurong GRC GROs and MP for Jurong GRC, shared with the residents that this NRP is more than the usual, as it includes Sport Singapore's Sports in Precinct (SIP) programme. When completed, Taman Jurong Park will feature new facilities such as a sprinting track, an adventurous children's playground, an iconic tree-house and sheltered games areas. It will cater to the different age groups and bring sports and recreation to your doorstep.

In addition, it will include new drop-off porches, children's playgrounds, fitness area and the upgrading of existing facilities like covered linkways and residents' corners.

The committee, made up of residents and grassroots leaders, with staff of the Town Council and Sport Singapore, held a preliminary survey to collect residents' wish lists and drew up some preliminary proposals. The preliminary proposals were exhibited and forums were held in October 2016. We had received very good feedback from the residents.

The entire project, estimated to cost over \$6.5 million, will be fully funded by the government. Residents do not have to pay for the NRP's improvement works.

We are delighted that over 80% of households supported the NRP and residents of Blocks 151 to 163 Yung Ho Road, Yung Loh Road & Yung Ping Road can look forward to benefit from a high quality, rejuvenated living environment.
