

Dear Residents,

Jurong-Clementi Town Council will continue to exercise prudence in its expenditures and adopt forward-looking initiatives in our operations. One way to do these is to promote cashless transaction to be in line with the Smart Nation initiative. Thus, we encourage residents to opt for cashless modes of payment, such as GIRO or the Recurring Credit Card Scheme, for payment of the service and conservancy charges (S&CC). By embracing cashless modes of payment, you will not need to make a trip to the Town Council office every month to make payment of S&CC.

As part of the budget announcement, the government is also providing S&CC rebate by up to 3.5 months for eligible HDB households.

In addition, the government recognises that family support is important. Hence, it is increasing the Proximity Housing Grant (PHG) for families buying a resale flat to live with their parents or children from \$20,000 to \$30,000. Eligible singles who want to live with their parents can also look forward to a higher PHG of \$15,000, up from the current \$10,000. If they buy a resale flat to live near their parents, they will now receive a PHG of \$10,000.

Last but not least, all Singaporeans aged 21 and above in 2018 will enjoy an SG Bonus of \$300, \$200 or \$100, depending on their income.

亲爱的居民：

裕廊—金文泰市镇理事会将继续开源节流。我们会配合打造智慧国的愿景，推广无现金交易，鼓励居民在缴付杂费时，选用财路(GIRO)或信用卡定期付款等无现金付款方式，以方便居民不需要每个月亲自到市镇会办事处付钱。

提到杂费，政府将给予符合资格的组屋住户高达3.5个月的杂费回扣。

在此，我也要借此机会与大家分享2018年财政预算案的几项重点。首先，政府意识到家庭支援的重要性。如您购买转售组屋与父母或子女同住，政府的津贴将从2万元提高到3万元。单身人士购买转售组屋与父母同住，所获津贴将从1万元提高到1万5000元不等。单身人士购买靠近父母家的转售组屋，则可获1万元津贴。

还有，每名21岁及以上的国人，将根据个别收入获得100元、200元或300元的“新加坡共享增长花红”(SG Bonus)。

Para penduduk yang dihormati,

Majlis Bandaran Jurong-Clementi akan tetap cermat berbelanja dan akan mengamalkan inisiatif berwawasan kepada operasi kami. Pengenalan pembayaran tanpa tunai adalah satu cara di mana kita dapat menjajar diri dengan inisiatif Negara Bijak. Oleh itu, kami menggalakkan penduduk untuk memilih cara pembayaran tanpa tunai, seperti GIRO atau Skim Kad Kredit Berulang, untuk pembayaran perkhidmatan dan penyenggaraan (S&CC). Dengan menerima cara pembayaran tanpa tunai, anda tidak perlu ke pejabat Majlis Bandaran setiap bulan untuk membayar S&CC anda.

Dalam pengumuman bajet, kerajaan juga telah menyediakan rebat S&CC sebanyak 3.5 bulan untuk isi rumah HDB yang layak.

Kerajaan juga mengiktiraf bahawa sokongan keluarga sangatlah penting. Oleh itu, ia meningkatkan Geran Perumahan Berhampiran (PHG) bagi keluarga yang bercadang membeli flat jualan semula untuk tinggal bersama ibu bapa atau anak mereka. Jumlah geran ini telah dinaikkan dari \$20,000 ke \$30,000. Warga bujang yang layak dan ingin tinggal bersama ibu bapa mereka juga boleh menikmati PHG yang lebih tinggi. Jumlah geran mereka akan dinaikkan dari \$10,000 ke \$15,000. Jika mereka membeli flat jualan semula yang berhampiran ibu bapa mereka, mereka kini akan menerima PHG sebanyak \$10,000.

Akhir sekali, semua warga Singapura berusia 21 tahun ke atas pada tahun 2018 akan menikmati Bonus SG sebanyak \$300, \$200 atau \$100, bergantung kepada pendapatan mereka.

ஜோரோங்கிளமெண்டி நகர மன்றம் அதன் செலவினங்களில் தொடர்ந்து விவேகத்தைக் கடைப்பிடித்து, அதன் செயல்பாடுகளில் முற்போக்கான முனைப்புகளை மேற்கொள்ளும். அறிவார்ந்த தேச முனைப்புகளுக்கு ஏற்ப ரொக்கமற்ற பரிவர்த்தனைகளை ஊக்குவிப்பது இதற்கான வழிகளில் ஒன்று. எனவே, சேவைப் பராமரிப்புக் கட்டணத்தைச் செலுத்த, ஜெரோ அல்லது கடன்பற்று அட்டை தொடர் கட்டணத் திட்டம் போன்ற ரொக்கமற்ற கட்டண முறைகளைப் பயன்படுத்துமாறு குடியிருப்பாளர்களை ஊக்குவிக்கிறோம். ரொக்கமற்ற கட்டண முறைகளைப் பயன்படுத்தும்போது, நீங்கள் ஒவ்வொரு மாதமும் சேவைப் பராமரிப்புக் கட்டணத்தைச் செலுத்த நகர மன்ற அலுவலகத்திற்குச் செல்ல வேண்டிய அவசியம் இருக்காது. வரவுசெலவுத் திட்டத்தின் ஒரு பகுதியாக, தகுதிபெறும் வீவக குடித்தனங்களுக்கு 3.5 மாதங்கள் வரையிலான சேவைப் பராமரிப்புக் கட்டணத் தள்ளுபடியை அரசாங்கம் வழங்குகிறது. அதோடு, குடும்ப ஆதரவு முக்கியம் என்பதையும் அரசாங்கம் அறிகிறது. எனவே, பெற்றோருடன் அல்லது பிள்ளைகளுடன் சேர்ந்து வாழ மறுவிழப்பனை வீடு வாங்கும் குடும்பங்களுக்கான நெருக்கம் ஊக்குவிக்கும் வீட்டு மானியத் தொகையை \$20,000-லிருந்து \$30,000 ஆக உயர்த்துகிறது. பெற்றோருடன் வாழ விரும்பும் தகுதிபெறும் மனமாகாதவர்கள் தற்போதைய \$10,000 மானியத்திற்குப் பதிலாக \$15,000 மானியம் பெறுவார்கள். பெற்றோருக்கு அருகில் மறுவிழப்பனை வீடு வாங்கும்போது, \$10,000 மானியம் பெறுவார்கள். இறுதியாக, இவ்வாண்டு 21 வயதுக்கு மேலான எல்லா சிங்கப்பூர்களும், தங்கள் வருமானத்தின் அடிப்படையில், \$300, \$200 அல்லது \$100 எஸ்ஜி போனஸ் பெறுவார்கள்.







HOW TO BE A GOOD NEIGHBOUR



Keep the noise level inside your residence within a reasonable level.



Observe quiet hours from 10pm to 7am.



Get to know your neighbours.



Keep the common corridor free of bulky items and accessible during any emergency evacuation.



Ensure that your pets are trained and suited to live in close proximity environment.



Keep your section of the common area clean and tidy.



Dispose litter or unwanted items at the designated rubbish bins.



Do not place objects in a haphazard manner.



Ensure that your laundry has been squeezed dry before hanging them out.

FACILITIES UPGRADE AND BETTER MOBILITY IN JURONG-CLEMENTI

提升裕廊-金文泰基础设施与衔接性

A new two-storey complex housing a market, coffee shop and a hub for active ageing will be built at Jurong West Street 41, replacing the wet market that was razed by fire in October 2016.

Unveiling its design on 17 December 2017 was Mr Ang Wei Neng, MP for Jurong GRC. He declared: "The two-storey building will be known as Jurong Central Plaza and will be an icon in our Jurong West neighbourhood." Mr Ang also announced the completion of rejuvenation works at Blocks 492-498 Jurong West Street 41 (N4), while the additional shop front renovation scheme for shop owners, known as Revitalisation of Shops (ROS), will complete in the first quarter of 2019.

The new complex features wider aisles that aid movement, non-slip tiles that enhance safety, and well-ventilated spaces for all to enjoy. It is due to complete by end 2018.

Mr Leo, 30, looks forward to patronising the new market. "My wife goes to the market twice every week to do grocery

shopping. The revamped market will make it easier for her to stock up fresh supplies of food for our family," he said.



The soft launch of SG Bike, Singapore's newest bicycle sharing operator, also took place that day. SG Bike uses geostations to detect if bicycles have been indiscriminately parked. These devices emit radio-frequency identification (RFID) fields detecting rogue bicycles that were parked outside designated spaces. When this happens, the bicycle will emit five sets of three quick beeps. The rider has 15 minutes to repark, or incur a penalty fee of \$1.

More yellow boxes will be drawn at void decks and neighbourhood centres to encourage responsible parking. "Hopefully this will shape the behaviour of users and build the confidence of residents in choosing SG Bike as a viable mode of transport," said Mr Ang.




Personal Mobility Device (PMD)*

(e.g. motorised wheelchair, mobility scooter etc.)

*PMDS must not weigh more than 20kg, have a maximum width of 70cm, and should have a maximum capped speed of 25km/h before they can be used on public paths





BEING PREPARED FOR EMERGENCIES

为防恐做好准备

An alert resident noticed a suspicious-looking man leaving two bags at a lamp post before hurrying away. He warned other residents to stay clear of the bags and called the police. Suddenly, the bags exploded.

Two masked gunmen appeared and started shooting at the crowd. An Emergency Response Team from the Singapore Police Force, trained in counter-assault skills, arrived to engage the gunmen and defuse the crisis. Members of the Taman Jurong Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) then performed cardiopulmonary resuscitation and used an automated external defibrillator on a rescued hostage who suffered a cardiac arrest.

Residents witnessed this scene, a terrorist attack simulation, during Emergency Preparedness Day held at Taman Jurong Community Club on 14 January 2018. Deputy Prime Minister Mr Tharman Shanmugaratnam, also the MP for Jurong GRC, advised: "Don't wait until you are sure that it is a terrorist attack, just report it immediately. When it happens, we must know how to react, protecting ourselves and neighbours and helping those who are injured."

Mr Sai, 42, brought his 13-year-old son to learn basic life-saving skills. "It is good to have a live exercise so that we can mentally prepare ourselves," he said.

An educational SGSecure community skit helped heighten residents' awareness of terrorist attacks, while a Patrol Escort Tactical Response Van capable of clearing temporary-erected barricades was showcased as well.



REJUVENATING THE IDENTITY OF YUHUA PLACE

Adding a serene beauty to Yuhua Place are its new lantern-shaped community pavilions that were recently completed, thanks to HDB's Remaking Our Heartland (ROH) initiative. Resembling the lanterns hung during the yearly Mid-Autumn Festival, these pavilions provide residents a space for recreational activities while doubling up as entrance markers to Yuhua Place's different entry points. The pavilions also add to the unique cultural identity of Yuhua Place.

On 17 December 2017, Minister for Culture, Community and Youth and MP for Yuhua SMC Ms Grace Fu marked the ROH completion at Yuhua Place Neighbourhood Centre at a ribbon-cutting ceremony held near Block 347 Jurong East Avenue 1. She then took a tour to view the open spaces, now enhanced with new floor finishes, landscaping and new light fixtures. Amenities catering to both the young and old such as bicycle racks, a children's play area, street furniture and fitness corners for the elderly were also retrofitted. Sports buffs will be glad that the flooring for the hardcourt at Block 347 has been improved. It is indeed heartening to witness residents' feedback, gathered during a mini-exhibition in June 2015, coming to fruition!


