Dear Residents,

The new 24km, 24-station Jurong Region Line (JRL) will open in three phases starting from 2026. Connecting residents in Jurong East, Jurong West, Yuhua, Bukit Batok to Boon Lay, Jurong Industrial Estate, Nanyang Technological University, Choa Chu Kang and more; the JRL will serve more than 200,000 commuters. This exciting milestone places 60,000 more households within a 10-minute walk from an MRT station.

Taking care of the elderly and the less privileged has always been one of our priorities. The Project Big Heart, a joint initiative between Jurong Central Grassroots Organisations, the Fullerton Healthcare and the Loving Heart Multi Service Centre (Jurong) was first held in 2015. For the 2018 edition on Sunday, 22 April 2018, 800 residents of Jurong GRC, Yuhua and Bukit Batok constituencies had a chance to go for specialised medical screening services, such as diabetic foot screening, bone mineral density test, 1-1 nutrition clinic, among others.

Thanks to the big hearts of our corporate and community partners, as well as volunteers, the project has benefited more than 2,500 patients since its inception. Over \$250,000 worth of medication has been dispensed.

It is heartwarming to note that we live in a community of considerate and caring residents. Read on to discover who they are, and be inspired by their “kampung spirit”! I would also like to thank all residents who participated in the “Keep Clean, Singapore! 2018” campaign, as well as our cleaners for their commitment in keeping our estates clean.

裕廊区域线将从2026年起分三阶段启用。新地铁线全长24公里，共有24个地铁站，将惠及裕廊东、裕廊西、裕华、武吉巴督、文礼和蔡厝港的居民，并把居民连接到裕廊工业区和南洋理工大学。新地铁线预计将为超过20万名乘客提供服务，届时，又有多6万户家庭只需步行10分钟，就能抵达地铁站。

另外，照顾年长者和弱势群体，向来是我们优先考虑的工作之一，其中一个项目是免费医疗社区服务—“关心计划”。这项计划由裕廊中基层组织、富乐医疗集团和爱心服务中心（裕廊）在2015年携手展开。今年4月22日（星期日），我们提供了升级版服务，800位裕廊集选区、裕华和武吉巴督单选区的居民获得专门医疗检查服务，如糖尿病足部检查、骨密度测试、一对一营养诊所等。

“关心计划”开始迄今，已有超过2500名病患从中受益。这期间也发放了超过25万元的药物。为此，我要感谢各个参与计划的企业和社区伙伴，以及义工们的爱心奉献。

这一期，我们也为大家介绍有爱心、处处为他人着想的居民。希望你们在翻阅他们的故事时，能被他们的“甘榜精神”启发。最后，我要在此感谢所有参与“保持清洁，新加坡！2018”运动的居民，以及努力保持我们家园干净的清洁工友。

Para penduduk yang dihormati,

Laluan Jurong Region (JRL) akan mula dibuka pada tahun 2026. Laluan rel ini akan memberi perkhidmatan kepada penduduk di daerah Jurong East, Jurong West, Yuhua, dan dari Bukit Batok ke Boon Lay, Kawasan Perindustrian Jurong, Universiti Teknologi Nanyang dan Choa Chu Kang. Lebih dari 200,000 penumpang akan mendapat manfaat dari JRL.

Pembangunan ini adalah satu pencapaian yang akan membolehkan lebih 60,000 isi rumah hanya perlu berjalan kaki dalam jarak 10 minit dari stesen MRT.

Kami akan teruskan usaha-usaha kami untuk membantu warga tua dan mereka yang kurang berkemampuan melalui pelbagai program. Antaranya adalah Projek Big Heart, sebuah program pemeriksaan kesihatan tahunan yang diurus secara bersama oleh badan-badan akar umbi Jurong Central, Fullerton Healthcare dan Pusat Berbagai Khidmat Loving Heart (Jurong). Projek Big Heart telah diadakan pada 22 April tahun ini, di mana 800 penduduk GRC Jurong dan kawasan undi Yuhua dan Bukit Batok menerima pemeriksaan kesihatan khusus seperti pemeriksaan kaki buat pesakit kencing manis, ujian ketumpatan mineral tulang dan klinik pemakanan.

Oleh kerana sifat murni rakan-rakan korporat, masyarakat dan sukarelawan kami, lebih daripada 2,500 pesakit telah menerima perkhidmatan berfaedah dan perubatan yang bernilai \$250,000.

Kami mengimpikan sebuah kehidupan masyarakat di mana ramai penduduk mempunyai sifat bertimbang rasa. Terus membaca untuk mengetahui siapakah mereka. Kami harap cerita-cerita mereka akan memberi inspirasi kepada semua! Saya juga ingin mengucapkan terima kasih kepada penduduk-penduduk yang mengambil bahagian dalam kempen "Singapura Bersih 2018", serta pekerja pembersih kami atas kerja keras mereka terhadap penjagaan kebersihan kawasan perumahan kami.

புதிய 24 கிமீ, 24-நிலையமுள்ள ஜுரோங் வட்டாரத் தடம் (ஜுவத) 2026ல் இருந்து மூன்று கட்டங்களாகத் திறக்கப்படும். ஜுரோங் கிழக்கு, ஜுரோங் மேற்கு, யுஹூ வா, புக்கிட் பாதோக்கில் உள்ள குடியிருப்பாளர்களை பூன் லே, ஜுரோங் தொழிற்பேட்டை, நான்யாங் தொழில்நுட்ப பல்கலைக்கழகம், சுவா கு காங் மற்றும் பல பகுதிகளுக்கு இணைப்பதுடன், ஜுவத 200,000 அதிகமான பயணிகளுக்கு சேவையாற்றும். இந்த உற்சாகமான மைல்கல் 600,000 குடும்பங்களை எம்ஆர்டி நிலையத்திலிருந்து 10 நிமிட நடைக்குள் வைக்கிறது. வயதானவர்களையும், குறைந்த சலுகைப் பெற்றவர்களையும் பிக் ஹார்ட் திட்டம், ஜுரோங் அடித்தள அமைப்புகள், ஃபுலர்டான் ஹெல்த்கேர், மற்றும் லவ்லிங் ஹார்ட் பல சேவை மையத்தின் (ஜுரோங்) ஒரு கூட்டு முயற்சியாகும், இது 2015ல் முதன் முதலாக நடத்தப்பட்டது. 2018க்கான பதிப்புக்காக ஞாயிற்றுக்கிழமை, 22 ஏப்ரல் 2018 அன்று, ஜுரோங் GRC, யுஹூவா, மற்றும் புக்கிட் பாதோக் தொகுதிகளின் 800 குடியிருப்பாளர்கள் நீரிழிவு பாதப் பரிசோதனை, எலும்புத் தாது அடர்த்திப் பரிசோதனைகள் மற்றும் 1-1 ஊட்டச்சத்து மருந்தகம், போன்ற சிறப்பு மருத்துவப் பரிசோதனைகளை பெருவதற்கான ஒரு வாய்ப்பினைப் பெற்றார்கள். எங்களின் பெருநிறுவன மற்றும் சமுதாயப் பங்குதாரர்கள், அதோடு தொண்டர்களின் பரந்த மனங்களுக்கு நன்றி, இந்தத் திட்டம் துவக்கம் முதல் 2,500 நோயாளிகளுக்குப் பலன் அளித்துள்ளது. \$250,000 தொகைக்கு மேல் மதிப்புள்ள மருந்துகள் வழங்கப்பட்டுள்ளன.

The 24 stations map of Jurong Region Line

Scheduled to open between 2026 and 2028, the 24-station Jurong Region Line (JRL) is hailed as a quantum leap in the development of Jurong's transport infrastructure. Its highlights include: -

- Serving five key areas in the west: JRL will serve some 200,000 commuters in Jurong East, Jurong West/Boon Lay, Jurong Industrial Estate, Nanyang Technological University (NTU) and Choa Chu Kang.
- Reduction of commute time: Residents living in the five key areas can find an MRT station within a 10-minute walk thanks to increased connectivity.
- Redistribution of train load: JRL will ease loading on existing lines between Jurong East and Choa Chu Kang MRT stations.
- **Three phases of opening:**
 - **Phase 1** (2026): JRL (West) – 10 stations linking Choa Chu Kang to Boon Lay and Tawas;
 - **Phase 2** (2027): JRL (East) – seven stations connecting Tengah and Pandan Reservoir; and
 - **Phase 3** (2028): Extensions to NTU in the west and Jurong Pier in the south, completing the JRL (West) route.

HIGH COVERED LINKWAY IN JURONG EAST 裕廊东高盖走廊

Rain or shine, residents at Blocks 347 Jurong East Street 31 and 316 Jurong East Street 32 enjoy sheltered connectivity between Yuhua Place Market and Chinese Garden MRT. This is made possible with the launch of a high covered linkway. On 12 May 2018, Minister for Culture, Community and Youth Grace Fu, who is also MP for Yuhua SMC, and Jurong GRC MP Mr Ang Wei Neng officiated the launch.

The high covered linkway commenced construction in December last year, and was completed in May 2018. This is part of a pilot trial which paves the way towards a car-lite society in Singapore. With the hassle of carrying umbrellas removed, residents can do more grocery shopping at their favourite outlets. Thanks to the Land Transport Authority for making this happen!



THE MINDFUL 'KEEPER' OF TOH GUAN PARK'S BLK 285B 卓源园的守护者



If you live in Block 285B on Toh Guan Road, chances are you already know who Madam Jun Kok Woon Thye is. The 59-year-old is well-known among her fellow neighbours for being the vigilant eyes and ears of Toh Guan Park neighbourhood. Thanks to her active involvement in the Residents Committee (RC) here, Madam Kok is almost regarded as a 'keeper' of the block.

Under her watchful eyes, unsavoury characters would find it difficult to smoke and consume alcohol openly at night at the Study Corner without being chased away by the police. "I think I've reported such incidences at my block for more than 10 times now," said the mother of two, aged 26 and 34. "I have a daughter who comes back home from work at 1am on most nights. I do my best to keep her safe this way."

Having lived here for 19 years, Madam Kok, who is also RC secretary, makes it a point to let the elderly 'uncles and aunties' be in the know of current happenings. Often seen putting up notification posters at lifts and notice boards, she is also touted as a 'walking newsletter'.

Madam Kok might not have the faintest idea why she was nominated for the Good Neighbour Award ("I don't know *wor*, maybe I'm just a busybody"), but her fellow RC member Madam Rozanah Md Yazam knows it perfectly clear. "She's very active in the RC. She makes it for all meetings and she loves helping out," said the 37-year-old, who works as a logistics administrator.

"It's hard to find someone like her who cares for the neighbourhood. I hope my nominating her for the award will inspire others to be like her too," said Madam Rozanah.

A NATIONAL GARDEN IN THE HEARTLANDS

Jurong residents previewed plans for their dream heartland garden at the Jurong Lake Gardens (JLG) Central and East masterplan exhibition on 24 March 2018. Shaped by more than 14,000 suggestions gathered through roving exhibitions, townhall sessions and online surveys, the masterplan seeks to conserve natural heritage while introducing new features that showcase tropical horticulture, sustainability, community involvement and enhanced accessibility. These are the highlights of the exhibition.

Retaining the Sense of Familiarity

The main buildings and features in the Chinese and Japanese Gardens will be preserved as these hold special memories for Singaporeans.

Integrating Water with Plants and Landscape

Aquatic Gardens featuring more than 140 varieties of water lilies, the biggest collection in Singapore, will be built. Boardwalks extending across terraced ponds will enable visitors to observe and photograph the flowers up close. Other attractions include the Floral Show Garden, Nature Rambling Trail and Water Gallery Trail.

Sustainability through Smart Technology

Energy-efficient technology such as solar panels and automated irrigation systems will be installed.

Shared Experiences

JLG will be a place where a common identity is forged through shared experiences. A wide spectrum of activities such as concerts, thematic displays and farmers' markets will be held to forge stronger bonds in the community.

Enhanced Accessibility

An East-West cycling route will be built to connect Taman Jurong to Jurong Town Hall and Jurong East. Within the

Gardens, visitors can walk or jog along trails that are connected to key attractions.

Deputy Prime Minister and MP for Jurong GRC, Mr Tharman Shanmugaratnam, and Minister for National Development, Second Minister for Finance and Chairman of the Jurong Lake District Steering Committee, Mr Lawrence Wong, were present at the public exhibition. They also participated in a community tree planting that day at Jurong Lake Gardens West to celebrate the upcoming JLG.

"We've had a very productive consultation exercise... This is an important ground-up process to shape our national gardens in the heartlands together. When completed, we can all look forward to a beautiful green gem in the heart of the new Jurong Lake District," said Minister Wong.

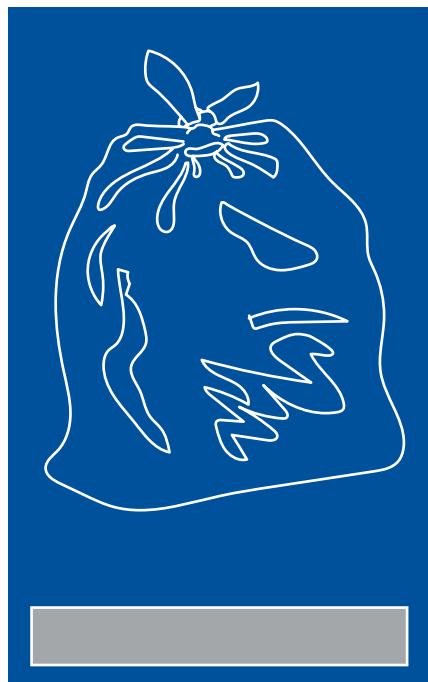
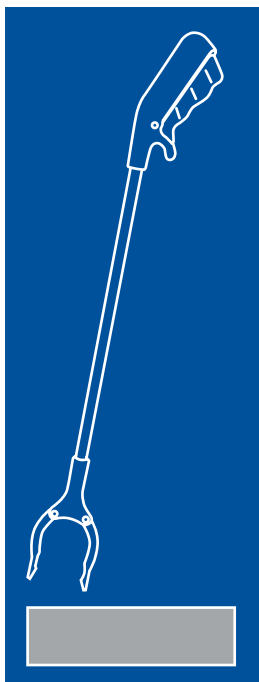
